### WHAT is a Montana Conservation License?

A Conservation License is required to access most state lands. You need to have a **Montana Conservation License** in your possession if you're at a fishing access site (FAS), wildlife management area (WMA) or to recreate/hike on any state land (which includes Jewel Basin).

Seniors: 62 + = \$4 Nonresident: \$10
